

Conference Interpreting Team



The Missouri Commission for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing is pleased to host the 23rd Annual Missouri Interpreters Conference. Please join the team of interpreters who will be providing services during this conference to be held at the Holiday Inn Executive Center in Columbia, MO on October 7-9, 2016. Any individual providing interpreting services must hold current certification in one or more of the following:

**MICS Master or Advanced
NAD Certified (Level 4 or 5)**

**BEI Master or Advanced
RID Certified (CI/CT or CSC)**

NIC/NIC Advanced/NIC Master

Individuals from outside of Missouri holding one of these certifications may be eligible to interpret in Missouri without a state interpreter license when temporarily in the state for the purpose of the Interpreters Conference.

All scheduled interpreters will be required to attend a brief meeting, to be held directly following the Keynote Address on Friday, October 7th at approximately 9 or 9:30 pm. If you are unable to attend this mandatory meeting, you will need to speak with Dee Sanfilippo at least two days in advance.

Individuals will NOT be eligible for CEUs during sessions for which they are providing interpreting services.

General Interpreter Compensation Packages:

- A) Compensation only at \$40/hour (required if working less than 3 hours)
- B) One night hotel & compensation at \$45/hour (working 3+ hours)
- C) Conference registration & compensation at \$45/hour (working 3+ hours)
- D) One night hotel & registration (working 3+ hours)
- E) Two nights hotel & compensation at \$45/hour (working 5+ hours)
