

## **Community Independent Living Specialist-Sensory Disabilities**

This is a full-time position that provides services to individuals which leads toward the attainment of greater independence. The person will provide information related to sensory disabilities, disability issues and rights, advocacy, service availability and access to services to individuals, organization and communities within the service area. The person must have knowledge of Deaf culture, Deafblind culture and American Sign Language and various types of hearing and vision losses. They must have knowledge of Braille. Missouri and Kansas RID licensure/certification requirements and the Americans with Disabilities Act is a plus. Extensive travel in the nine-county coverage area is required. The position requires the completion of Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in Social work, Rehabilitation, Psychology, or in a related human services field. Attention to detail is essential. Background check is required.
