Dr. Horejcs holds a Ph.D (2009) in Justice Studies at Arizona State University. Dr. Horejcs was a Project Leader with the City of Phoenix's Inclusion Services Division as a disability policy specialist where he monitored various ADA policy procedures. Before entering the Ph.D program, he was a community advocate for the Greater Los Angeles Agency on Deafness (GLAD) serving deaf and hard of hearing individuals in Los Angeles. Dr. Horejcs is Deaf and a native to Saint Louis (University City). Dr. Horejcs brings with him a wealth of experience in grant writing, managing and overseeing large budgets, developing policies and procedures, providing advocacy and empowerment in various areas to the deaf and hard of hearing consumers, collaboration with federal, state and regional agencies, providing sensitivity training and workshops to increase awareness of deaf and hard of hearing persons, among other areas of expertise.
