Each workshop in the 2024 series will dive into the process of analyzing interpreter situational dilemmas. Participants will discuss the situation and ethics involved with each scenario provided and then utilize the Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf's Code of Professional Conduct (CPC) to understand which tenet(s) and guiding behavior(s) have been affected. Participants will be prompted to share thoughts, suggest ideas, and describe alternate actions for the scenario. Working under the guidelines of the CPC allows interpreters to follow ethical practices that help us to maintain consistency within the field.

This workshop is presented as a forum for all attendees. The facilitator will engage with participants to share their thoughts and opinions— as related to each scenario— in a safe and respectful environment. You need **not** have attended any of the previous workshops to attend this one.
