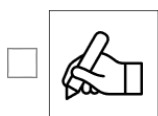
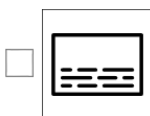


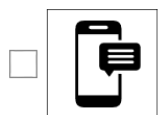

To help us communicate, please remember:


- Get my attention first.
- Look at me when you speak.
- I cannot lip-read everything you say.
- Writing notes may be helpful.
- Hearing aid/cochlear implant does not mean I understand all speech.
- Ask me what accommodations work for me.
