WORKSHOP TITLE: JOURNEY INTO DEAFHOOD

THIS 6-HOUR, DEAF-ONLY WORKSHOP OFFERS A CONDENSED INTRODUCTION TO KEY CONCEPTS FROM THE DEAFHOOD 101 COURSE. PARTICIPANTS EXPLORE THE MEANING OF THE WORD "DEAF," THE VITALITY OF DEAF COMMUNITIES IN EARLIER TIMES, AND THE ENVIRONMENTAL DIMENSIONS THAT INFLUENCE THE SHAPING OF DEAF IDENTITIES. JUST AS ADULTHOOD REFLECTS THE STATE AND EXPERIENCE OF BEING AN ADULT, AND NEIGHBORHOOD REFLECTS THE SHARED EXPERIENCE OF LIVING IN COMMUNITY, DEAFHOOD INVITES US TO EXPLORE THE STATE, EXPERIENCE, AND COLLECTIVE JOURNEY OF BEING DEAF. THROUGH GUIDED REFLECTION AND REFRAMING, PARTICIPANTS BEGIN TO RECLAIM THEIR NARRATIVES AND IMAGINE NEW POSSIBILITIES FOR WHAT IT TRULY MEANS TO LIVE AND THRIVE AS DEAF HUMAN BEINGS.
